In this post, we'll cover the tips and tricks to help you gain a better understanding of the platform so you can get the most out of your time spent exploring the current and future chapters of the CDM Program in FY20 and beyond.

Tip #1: Explore the platform

When becoming familiar with a new space, sometimes it's best just to click around and explore.

Here's the main lobby where you can enter the resource center, theater, exhibit hall, game center, and lounge. Here you can also access the help center if you need any technical assistance. Above the lobby, you'll find the main navigation panel where you can jump to the different rooms with easy access.



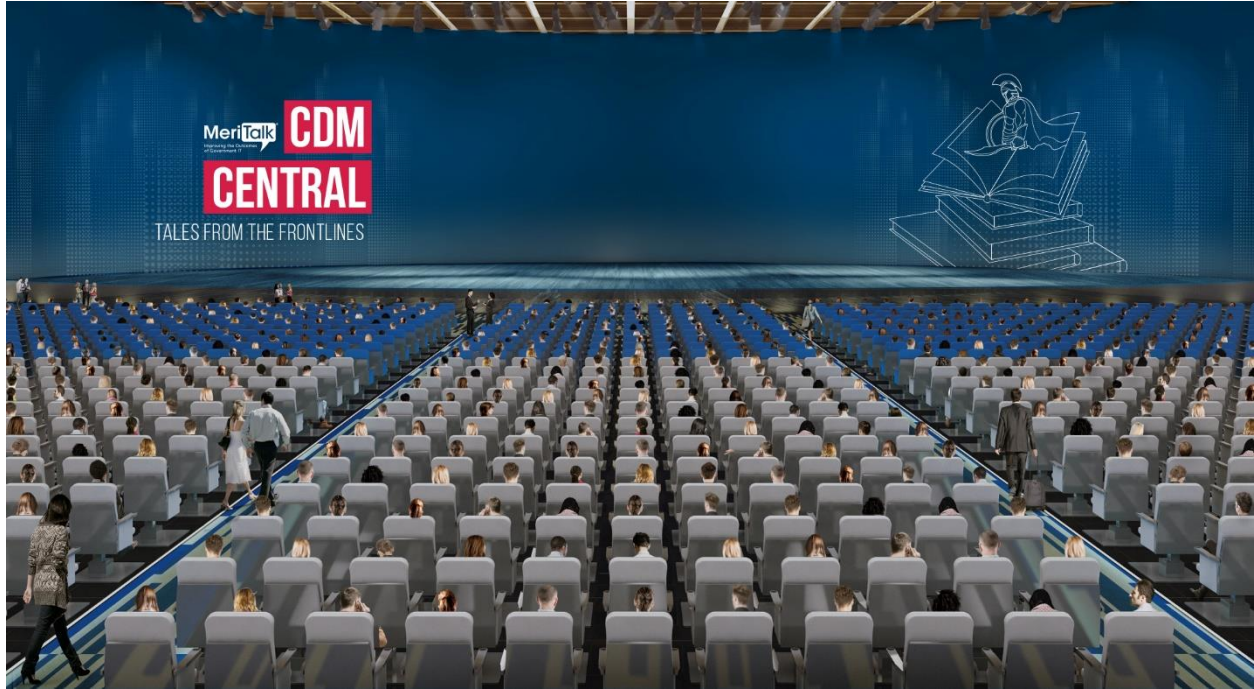
Tip #2: Network with our partners

In the Exhibitor Hall, you'll be able to engage with industry experts "face-to-face" in 1-on-1 chats or group chat channels, download resources, and participate in live demos.



Tip #3: Attend a Session

All sessions will be hosted in the Theater, including keynotes from Federal CISO Grant Schneider, CDM PMO Kevin Cox and CISA's Matt Hartman. Each session opens 5 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. Simply click on the launch button and enjoy. To qualify for CPE credits, you must attend a session for 10 minutes.



Tip #4: Join the conversation

In the Lounge, attendees can join and chat about the future of telework, TIC 3.0, and second iteration dashboard. Don't be shy! Make a network connection by entering one of the lounges throughout the day.



Tip #5: Badging

Attendees can earn badges by playing trivia, visiting partner booths, attending sessions, networking with attendees in group chats, and more. Top scorers will be displayed on the leaderboard for all attendees to see. Each badge is also worth a certain amount of points. Attendees with the highest number of points will be randomly selected to win one of our prizes.
